

Utilising AI with Ufonia's *Dora* to Automate Perioperative Cataract Surgery Appointments in BOB & Frimley ICBs

Background

Over **10,000 cataract surgeries** are performed across BHT, OUH, RBFT & FHFT annually. Routine cataract surgery appointments place a **significant burden on clinical staff time**. Meanwhile ophthalmology is the busiest outpatient specialty with some of the longest waiting lists.

Prior to implementing *Dora*, some trusts had **backlogs for follow-up appointments** meaning cataract patients were seen at 8 weeks (rather than the desired 3 weeks). Other trusts had a high proportion of face-to-face follow-ups, and **pre-op assessment availability was acting as a bottleneck**.

Introduction to Dora

Ufonia has developed *Dora*, an **Al-enabled clinical voice assistant**, that telephones patients and has routine clinical conversations with them.

Dora acts as a like-for-like replacement for routine cataract appointments, like pre-assessments and follow-ups. Dora can also confirm patient's attendance for surgery and collect patient reported outcome measures.

Dora has been deployed at BHT, OUH, RBFT & FHFT for the last 2 years and has automated over 20K calls to date.



Dora is **less than 10-20% the cost** of the tariff for an equivalent routine outpatient appointment

Cataract Pathway with *Dora*


Prior to implementing *Dora*, **routine cataract appointments occupied 14K hours of staff-time** annually across BOB and Frimley.



Automated cataract appointments now save staff approximately 40 minutes to 1 hour per patient

Future Work

'Assumptions: New outpatient appointments are 30min, Non-RTT follow-ups are 15min, Intraocular injections are 15min
